Solid and rhythmic glazing mullions define the store’s boundary line, standing as a conscious separation from the rest of the shopping centre while supporting the notion of privacy and exclusivity. Within the store the design is clean and crisp, with product display and storage seamlessly integrated. Deep, ebonized timber tones contrast with the soft, warm greys of the stone, evoking strength and confidence.
